Sustainability Leadership Scorecard: Shipley College Report - 2024/25


The EAUC Sustainability Leadership Scorecard (SLS) provides the Tertiary Education sector with a development framework that allows institutions to understand their current position with regards to issues of sustainable development and assist in developing routes for improvement. The framework is designed to align with the wider challenges facing the sector, highlighting that sustainable development issues are a key part of the overall business strategy of an institution.

The EAUC SLS comprises of 18 standard frameworks developed to address current and emerging sustainability themes important to the sector. Shipley College currently scores on 17 of these 18 standard frameworks, therefore the average overall score in this report is based on the 17 scored frameworks. Frameworks are grouped within four priority areas: Leadership and Governance; Partnerships and Engagement; Learning, Teaching and Research; and Estates and Operations. Each framework is made up of 8 activities and scoring is given at an activity level, with scores ranging from 0-4 per framework activity - see further detail in the report.


This SLS report includes two scores for Shipley College - One based on the highest possible score of 32 per framework and one based on the target score that Shipley College has created per framework. The score and award, based on the college's target score, will be used in this report as it gives a realistic representation of where Shipley College is with its sustainable development. Overall award based on % of target score - *Gold* (76%)




Key actions for next year - Estates and Operations Framework

- 4. Review the Shipley College Travel Plan and complete an up to date staff and student travel survey


