## Filming & road closures in Saltaire

Dear Parents, Carers and Next of Kin,

We are writing to make you aware of temporary traffic arrangements around Shipley College over the next three days due to filming taking place in the local area. This is likely to result in **significant traffic congestion**, particularly at the beginning and end of the College day.

To support the safety of our students, staff and the wider local community, we ask that **cars do not turn onto Exhibition Road from Saltaire Road** during the following times:

- **8.45am–9.00am**
- **4.00pm–4.30pm**

During these periods, traffic on Exhibition Road will operate **one way**. Vehicles will travel up Exhibition Road and turn right onto either **Mawson Street or Titus Street**, before exiting the area via the top of Victoria Road.

## Essential access for students with high needs and Local Authority-arranged transport

We recognise that some students require specific transport arrangements. **Essential vehicles providing Local Authority-arranged transport for students with high needs will still be able to access the College for drop-off and collection.**

Vehicles requiring essential access should:

- Turn onto **Exhibition Road from Caroline Street**.
- Use **Titus Street and Mawson Street** to travel through the area.
- Exit onto **Saltaire Road**.

Where it is essential for the safe transport of a student, cars will also be permitted to **travel up Exhibition Road for collection purposes only**.

**Emergency services will be granted access at all times where required in the event of an emergency.**

We ask all parents and carers to plan their journeys carefully and allow additional time, as congestion is expected. Please follow the temporary traffic directions and refer to the attached map to help us minimise disruption.

Most importantly, we ask everyone to exercise particular care and patience around the College during this period to ensure the safety of our **students, staff and local community**.
